



INSTRUCTION FOR ABSTRACT

Uploaded file should be included of following structure:

- 1. Abstracts must be written in English and submitted as Word file only in A4 format, using the font Cambria 10 and the online submission form.
- 2. Abstracts should be no more than 250 words, completely self-explanatory, briefly present the topic, state the scope of the experiments, indicate significant data, and point out major findings and conclusions.
- 3. All authors have to note their full names, academic degrees, institutional affiliations and locations.
- 4. Designate one author as the corresponding author with complete address; including e-mail address, postal code and mobile number. (The corresponding author will be the one who presents the article, either oral or as a poster).
- 5. Use generic names for drug or agents.
- 6. Use the standard abbreviations.
- 7. Do not include references.
- 8. The structured abstract for an original investigation should be organized as follows:

Introduction: The abstract should begin with a clear statement of the precise objective or question addressed in the paper. If a hypothesis was tested, it should be stated.

Methods: The basic design of the study and its duration should be described. The methods used should be stated, the statistical data/methods provided and referenced.

Results: The main results of the study should be given in narrative form. Measurements or other information that may require explanation should be defined. Levels of statistical significance should be indicated, including other factors crucial to the outcome of the study.

Conclusions: State only conclusions that are directly supported by the evidence and the implications of the findings.

Keywords: 3 to 6 descriptive keywords chosen from the Medical Subject Headings (MeSH) list. Keywords should be selected from the body of the text and not duplicate title words and should be sorted alphabetically.
